Suzanne Déoux is doctor in medicine, associated professor at the university of Angers where she created the first master "health risks in the built environment", President of the "Association bâtiment santé plus, which organises, in Angers, an annual congress on "the challenges Building & health" and "the trophies of building and health".

Specialized in oto-laryngology, she became a forerunner in environmental medicine. The relationship between health and building has been the focus of her professional activity since 1986. During that year, the company MEDIECO -advice and training in health strategy within the urban and built environment- was created. She carries out quality analysis AQS with the industry for construction product and equipment for construction.

She proposes approaches for health performance diagnostic DPS of existing buildings and for "bâtiment santé plus" for the conception of new buildings. She intervenes and organizes many training for construction and health professionals.

She is the author of various articles and books: *L'écologie, c'est la santé* (1993), *Habitat qualité santé, clefs en mains* (1997), *Le Guide de l'habitat sain* (2002, deuxième édition 2004), *Bâtir pour la santé des enfants* (2010) et *Bâtiment, Santé, le tour des labels* (2011).
