1990 - 2006 Assistant/deputy head of division at the Federal Ministry for Regional Planning, Building and Urban Development (subsequently Federal Ministry of Transport, Building and Housing), responsible for energy-efficient building.

Main areas of activity: fleshing out and coordinating the Energy Conservation Regulations; issues relating to building research and modernization of the building stock; cooperation with Eastern Europe in the field of building.

Since 2007

Head of Division B 13, "Civil engineering; sustainable construction; building research", at the Federal Ministry of Transport, Building and Urban Affairs in Berlin. Responsible for sustainable construction and the "Future of Building" research initiative. Highest technical authority for federal buildings.
